[1ra-1vb, lections for the Holy Week]: Luke 22:34-23:7. [2r]: [Sabbato sancto] ... numerum dignatus est ... *Versus* Vere dignum et iustum est... [2v] [Dominica de passio] Pangu lingua gloriosi prelium ... *in uigilia pascha* Exultae iam angelica...

Structure

2 fol. Parchment. 20 x 26,5 (16,5 x 24,5)*. The leaves have been trimmed and both are missing text. 31 (or more) ruled lines in two columns. Both folia show damage from glue and water.

Script

Carolingian minuscule, saec. XII. Neumatic notation.

Decoration

Simple initials and rubrics in red (the colour is almost completely faded).

Provenance

Fol. 2r, in a saec. XVI(?) hand: 'Liber Ecclesiae Canga:[sala]'. The folia have been removed from the covers of a saec. XVI book that belonged to Kangasala church. The covers were recovered under the church floor in 1896.

Binding

The leaves were part of the covers of a saec. XVI binding.

History

The two folia have been used as pastedowns in a book that belonged to Kangasala church. The book has since been lost, but the covers have survived. The folia stem from a saec. XII manuscript. It is uncertain how the manuscript ended up in Finland.
