### *Structure*

Two strips of parchment probably from two different bifolia. 24,50 x 2,5\*. Two lines of texts visible in two columns.

### *Script*

A protogothic minuscule script in a saec. XIII hand.

### *Decoration*

Red initials

### *Provenance*

There is no information on provenance. The fragments probably stem from a church in Finland.

### *Binding*

No binding

### *History*

The origins and provenance of the fragments are unknown. The script suggests that the manuscript originated from abroad.
